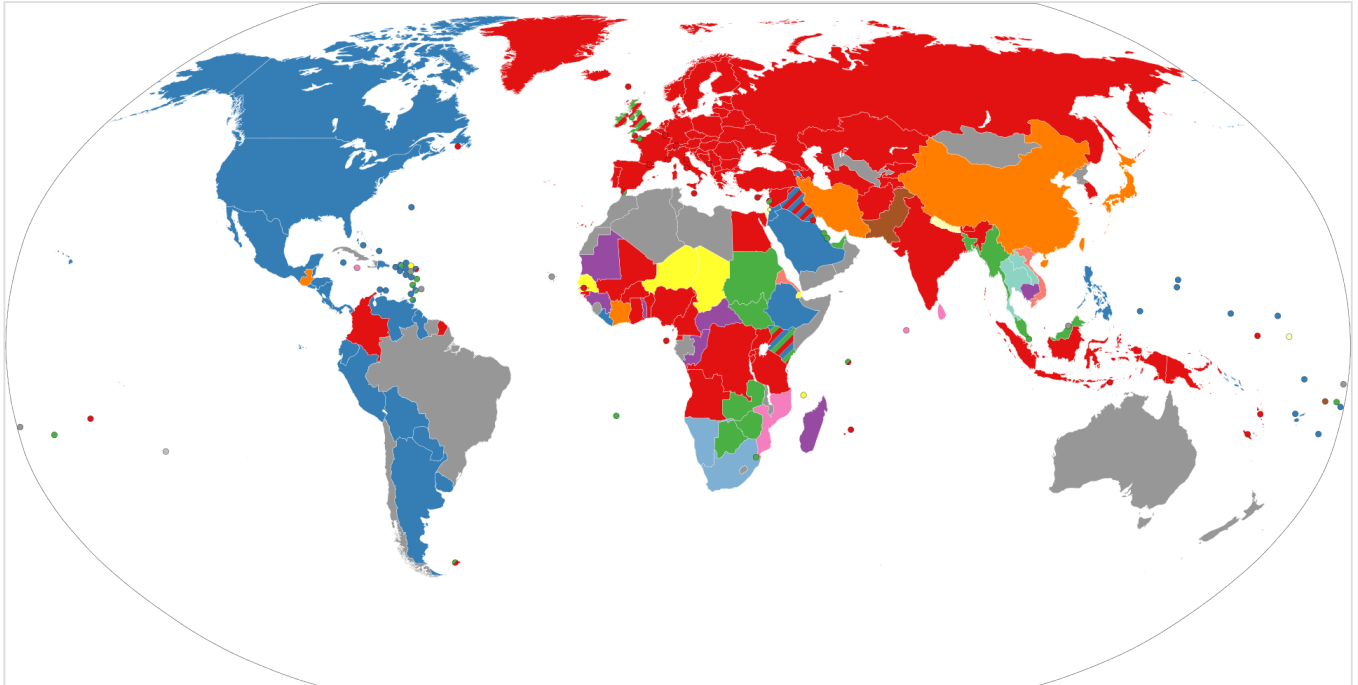















List of emergency telephone numbers

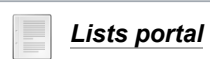
